Find a doctor, medical specialist, hospital or lab

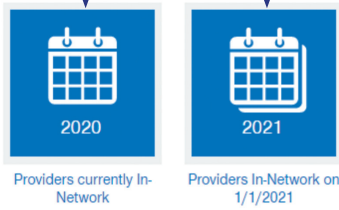


**Behavioral Health Directory**

- 1 Go to [uhc.com/providersearch](https://uhc.com/providersearch), select the **Medical Directory** tile, followed by the **All UnitedHealthcare Plans** tile. (If you're asked "Are you a current UnitedHealthcare member or are you shopping for a health plan?" choose the **Shopping Around** tile.) Next, choose the name of the health plan your employer is offering.

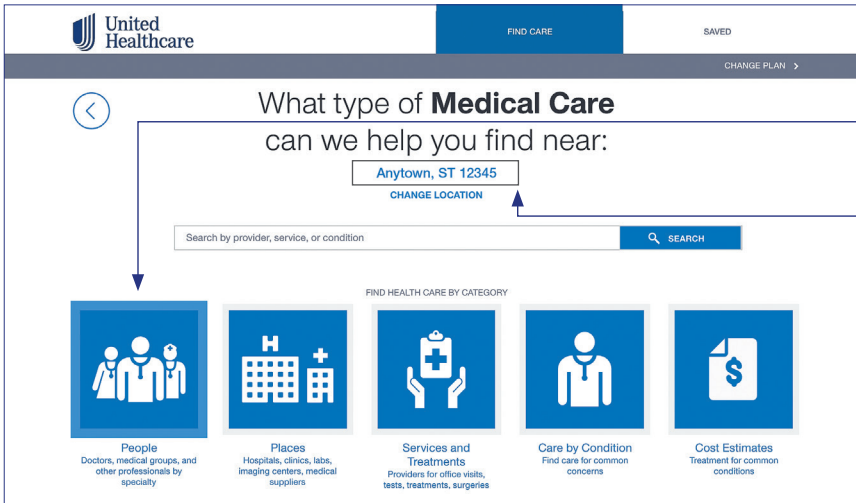
Not sure which plan name to look for? Check your open enrollment materials or ask your employer.

## When will you be receiving care?



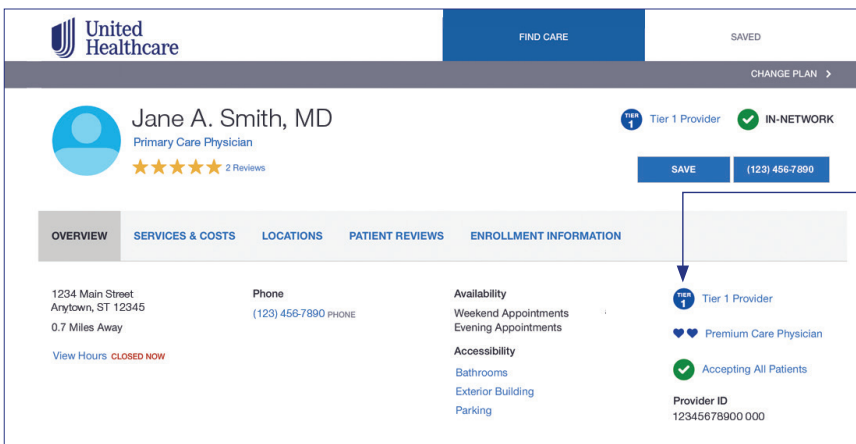
2 Next, select the calendar tile that corresponds to the year in which you're seeking care.

**Note:** Calendar tiles only appear during open enrollment (October – December of the current year)—so this step may not always apply.



3 To browse the list of providers within the network, choose **People**. Then, depending on your needs, select **Primary Care** or **Specialty Care**.

You may need to change your location in order to search providers near you.



4 Spot the blue dot to find providers that have Tier 1 status.
