Getting care with Navigate plans

Navigate

Visits to specialists within the Navigate network require electronic referrals from the member's PCP before the specialist visit. Out-of-network care is not covered, except in the case of an emergency.

Navigate Plus

Visits to specialists within the Navigate network are covered at the lowest member cost-share with electronic referrals. Network and out-of-network specialists visits without referrals are covered, but the member will pay more.
