Our Oxford¹ Liberty Network is our more focused mid-sized option for New Jersey employers seeking a better balance between costs and employee satisfaction. Highlights of these plans include fitness incentives that offer rewards for reaching fitness goals, discounts to thousands of gyms without long-term contracts, and other ways to help lower out-of-pocket costs like \$0 cost-share for certain vital medications.

Access to doctors, hospitals and pharmacies nearby or nationwide

Local access – The Oxford Liberty Network provides access across New Jersey, New York and Connecticut with more than 168,000 providers:²

- New Jersey providers: 47,462
- New York providers: 90,435
- Connecticut providers: 30,154

Pharmacy – Broad access to approximately 67,000 retail pharmacies nationwide, including major chains, mass merchants and supermarkets

- Examples of network pharmacies include CVS[®], Duane Reade[™], Walgreens[®] and Walmart[®]

National access – Members enrolled in Oxford Liberty Network plans have additional access to our national UnitedHealthcare Core network² when traveling outside of the Oxford service area:³
