



How to search online for Oxford providers

The provider search feature on myuhc.com[®] is a convenient way to find network medical, behavioral health and other providers near you. Using doctors and facilities in the network typically saves you money, so staying in network makes sense. Depending on your plan, visiting an out-of-network provider could end up costing you a lot more for care or may not be covered at all.


Depending on your Oxford benefits plan, you may have out-of-area access to the Freedom with Choice Plus, Liberty with Core or Metro with Core network when outside of the Oxford service area.¹ This means you may receive in-network benefits for covered health care services provided by a doctor or facility participating in your plan's national network – either Choice Plus or Core. Please verify a doctor's or other provider's participation status by calling their office directly or by calling us at the number on your health plan ID card.

Find medical and behavioral providers in your Oxford network

- 1 Go to myuhc.com
- 2 Select **Find a Provider**
- 3 Choose **Medical Directory** for medical providers or **Behavioral Health Directory** for behavioral health providers
- 4 Choose **Employer and Individual Plans**
- 5 Scroll down and select **Oxford Health Plans**. Then, select your plan:
 - Freedom with Choice Plus
 - Liberty with Core
 - Metro with Core (NJ sitused plans only)
 - Metro (NY sitused plans)
- 6 Type in the ZIP code where you are searching for care
- 7 Finally, select the health care category you'd like to search, or use the search bar if you know the doctor's name, specialty, facility, clinic or medical group name
