Flu shots help keep employees protected and productive

Each flu season, nearly 111 million workdays are lost due to the flu. That equals approximately \$7 billion per year in sick days and lost productivity.¹ A flu shot is the best defense against the flu—and getting one can help protect the people around you.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends annual flu shots for everyone 6 months and older.² Encourage your employees to protect themselves and others by getting a flu shot.

Convenient provider access makes getting flu shots easier

UnitedHealthcare contracts with a variety of national pharmacy chains and retail convenience care clinics to offer members easy access to flu shots.

Annual flu shots are covered by most plans at \$0 out-of-pocket when members use one of the following network providers.³ Members should bring their health plan ID card and tell their provider the flu shot is covered under their benefits.
