Finding a doctor, specialist or facility couldn't be easier. Just follow the steps below.



1 Go to myuhc.com®

- Select **Find a Provider**
- Select **Medical Directory**
- Select **Employer and Individual Plans**

2 Select your plan type

- Select **SignatureValue Plans**
- Select the state in which you live
- Select **SignatureValue Harmony HMO** for your network
- Enter your ZIP code or city and state

3 Search by people or place

To search by people:

Select **Primary Care**, **Specialty Care** or **Medical Groups**

- For **Primary Care**: Select a type of **Primary Provider** (Family Doctor, Generalist, Internist, etc.)
- For **Specialty Care**: Select a type of **Specialist** (Acupuncturist, Allergist/Immunologist, etc.)
- For **Medical Groups**: Select your **Medical Group Name**

To search by place:

Select **Hospitals** or **Specialty Centers**

- For **Hospitals**: Select the **Location**
- For **Specialty Centers**: Select a type of **Specialty Center** (Birth Centers, Blood Banks, Community Clinics, etc.)

- Once a PCP has been selected, click on the **Locations** tab.
